Renewal 2009 (exposure period 2010/2011)

We kindly remind you that the following colours will be tested in Florida during the years 2010/2011:

RAL 1019 (Grey beige) Delta E 3
RAL 6029 (Mint green) Delta E 5
RAL 9011 (Graphite black) Delta E 5
(2 out of the 3 colours)

plus a metallic colour (RAL 9006 / RAL 9007)
with a maximum acceptable Delta E of 2
in the case that metallic powders are approved.

Please note that if the requested colours do not belong to the standard production, samples have to be manufactured especially for the tests. Similar colours will not be accepted anymore.

We also remind you that if a powder manufacturer fails for any reason to submit the required colours to the laboratory on time (i.e. until 31.12.2009) and if no panels are sent to Florida as a result, two of the colours and one metallic colour will be banned, as specified by QUALICOAT.

If you don't intend to renew an approval and if you haven't informed us yet, kindly send us this information by e-mail or fax **until 30 November 2009** at the latest. We will then transfer the system into the list of cancelled approvals with the indication "cancelled by supplier".

We remain at your disposal for any further information and explanation.
